This text, in Asher's hand, is then THE preferred Jewish version of the text of the Jewish bible. It is widely said that the early part of the manuscript was lost in a fire early in the Twentieth Century, but a cursory examination of the facsimile reveals that this is not the case. I have been told by someone close to the Aleppo Codex Trust that the missing pages were actually stolen. A few of the missing pages have been recovered, but I don't believe that they are included in this facsimile or for that matter in any published form anywhere. The manuscript begins mid-verse Chapter 28, Verse 17 of the Book of Deuteronomy and includes all of the Prophets and the Writings. The pages are very well preserved for the most part although the bottom open corners are pictured as having the usual stained corners that heavily used books get.
